

Tewin Tennis Courts

The original single tennis court here was built in 1971 following a donation to Tewin Parish Council specifically to provide a tennis court for the Parish. Tewin Tennis Club manages these courts on behalf of the Parish Council and keeps the Club membership fees as low as possible (less than 50% of any other local club) so that everyone can afford to join the Club. However, we would like to bring to the attention of all persons resident in the Parish that they may use these courts without joining the Club, provided that they abide by the normal booking and playing Rules. We ask for a contribution towards maintenance of £5 per hour per court (£2.50 for juniors). A key is available from Tewin Stores.
